TCS London Marathon 2022 Terms and Conditions

1. If you are allocated a 999 Club Golden Bond place for the 2022 London Marathon, you will be required to pay a non-refundable registration fee of £50 to secure your place. If you have not paid within 10 days, we will assume you no longer want this place and your application will not be taken further.

2. By registering for a 999 Club Gold Bond place in the 2022 London Marathon you are agreeing to a fundraising target of £2,200. 80% of the total sum raised should be sent to the 999 Club at least 4 weeks prior to the 2022 marathon with the remainder being sent no later than one month after the event (which takes place on Sunday 2 October 2022), and you understand that it is the aim of this challenge to raise as much as possible. This does not include any Gift Aid claimed against your sponsorship or the event registration fee.

4. Unless discussed with the team in advance, it is expected that matched funding (if available) will be in addition to your £2,200 target. Matched funding is not always guaranteed until the application is accepted after the event.

5. You agree to represent and raise money exclusively for the 999 Club in this event. 999 Club reserves the right to withdraw the offer of a place if the runner does not raise the required funds or brings the name of the charity into disrepute.

6. No refund will be made in event of cancellation by you, the event organiser or the 999 Club as sponsorship raised is for charitable purposes.

7. Should you have to withdraw for any reason, you should inform the 999 Club in writing, send all sponsorship forms and money collected directly to the 999 Club, and notify your sponsors/supporters that you are no longer taking part. All sponsorship monies will be retained by the 999 Club unless your sponsors request in writing that the 999 Club return it to them within one month of your cancellation (not applicable for online donations).

8. If you are in any doubt as to your physical ability to take part in this event, you must seek medical advice from your general practitioner. Please do not run if you are injured or feeling poorly.

9. You are entering this event entirely at your own risk and the 999 Club shall not be liable for any injury or loss that might occur as a result of your participation.

10. You must be at least 18 years old by race day (Sunday 2 October 2022).

11. If successful, the final registration step is to sign up to the London Marathon console. You will receive an email from the London Marathon organisers and need to complete the final stages within 10 days of receiving the email, otherwise we will assume you no longer want your London Marathon place.

12. You hereby agree that images or footage taken of our runners at the event may be used by the 999 Club in future promotional material including our website, social media and charity magazines and reports, unless stated otherwise.
